Feast Day of the Apostles Peter and Paul This year the Feast Day of the Apostles Peter and Paul falls on Sunday, June 29. This is one of five obligatory Holy Days for all Eastern Catholics. Saints Peter and Paul first ministered in Antioch, the ancestral seat of our patriarchate and one of the greatest of early Christian Cities. Eventually they traveled to Rome and ministered there. It was in Rome



that both were killed for Christ. Saint Paul was beheaded at Tre Fontane outside of Rome. Eventually a huge basilica was built over his tomb. Saint Peter was crucified upside down on the Vatican Hill and later on Saint Peter's Basilica was built over his grave. They are the Patron Saints of both Rome and Antioch.
