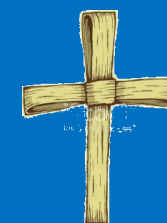

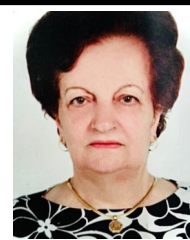
Annual Lenten Supper

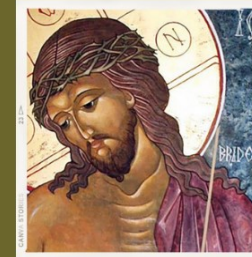
